Introduction

Thank you for choosing a Bio-Art product.

The Fork Support is an accessory for use in Bio-Art's articulators and has been designed to provide greater stability of cast impression, preventing undesired distortions.

2Packaging Contents

The Fork Support assembled set consists of the following items:

Part 01 - Base nut;

Part 02 - Fork support rod;

Part 03 - Support spindle;

Part 04 - Height adjustment screw;

Part 05 - Support sheet central pin

3Installation

The Fork Support should be assembled on the lower frame of the articulator and properly secured by the same screw used on the mounting plate or by the frame's magnet as shown below.

4Instructions for use

- 1. With the Facebow and the respective fork positioned in the articulator and the Fork Support secured to the articulator lower frame, only turn the spindle (03) for a preview selection of the support sheet (02) height in relation to the fork:
- 2. Then with one hand hold the sheet (02) and with the other turn the height adjustment screw (04) until it reaches the fork so that the Fork Support functions as a "wedge", therefore, providing stability and firmness for the impression when the plaster cast is fixed in the articulator, avoiding undesired distortions;

Note: The support sheet (02) can be moved in the horizontal plane in order to be accurately adjusted upon contact with the fork.



Caution: This manual contains only the basic and simplified information regarding the product, which does not replace proper course and training. The Fork Support is a product intended for use only by specially qualified professionals in the area, who are fully responsible for the technique used.

5Troubleshooting

PROBLEMS	POSSIBLE CAUSE	SOLUTION
Difficulty in handling (turning) the adjusting screw (04).	Plaster residues on threads.	Clean the threads of parts 01.03 and 04 and lubricate with a small amount of neutral lubricant.
Difficulty in horizontal movement of the support sheet (02).	Residues or dirt on the sheet (05) shaft.	Clean the support sheet (05) shaft and lubricate with a small amount of neutral lubricant.
Difficulty in attaching the Base nut (01) to the lower arm of the articulator.	Residues or dirt on the fixing thread of the Base nut (01).	Check the threads of the Base nut (01) and the mounting plate locking screw and clean if necessary.

6Maintenance and cleaning


- For cleaning the Fork Support, use only a dry cloth and do not use solvents, detergents or chemicals;
- Do not use metal or sharp objects to clean any part, if necessary use a plastic spatula;
- Lubricate the threads and pin (05) when necessary using a small amount of neutral lubricant;
- With the exception of cleaning and lubrication, no maintenance should be performed by the user. Always seek Authorized Technical Support
